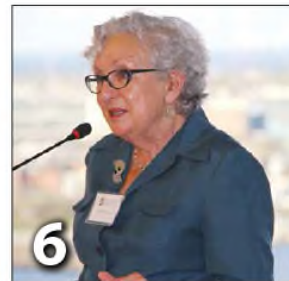


Longtime civil rights champion recognized with namesake fund
